

Salvation Army Star-Search 2008 **Contest Rules and Conditions**

1. Applications for the “Star-Search 2008” solo competition must be received no later than April 12th, 2008.
2. The competition will take place on Saturday, April 19th, 2008. Events will take place throughout the day at The Salvation Army Mississauga Temple Community Church, 3173 Cawthra Road.
3. The “Star-Search 2008” solo competition is open to brass instrumentalists who reside within the Region of Peel, and who are currently enrolled in school grades 7 through 12.
4. Application forms must be endorsed by the contestant’s school music teacher, confirming eligibility and appropriateness of selection difficulty.
5. Members of any Salvation Army music programme MAY NOT participate in the solo contest.
6. Participants/attendees will be respectful of the other participants in the competition events and programmes.
7. Participants/attendees unconditionally agree to accept as final the decision of contest adjudicators.
8. In each of three difficulty levels, winning contestants will receive a commemorative trophy/plaque, a \$100 cash prize, and a \$50 gift certificate from one of the event sponsors.
9. Prizes for winning contestants are awarded on the following conditions:
 - a. Winning contestants will perform their solo selection in the “Awards Ceremony and Gala Programme” on the evening of Saturday, April 19th, 2008.
 - b. Winning contestants agree to visit Mississauga Temple Salvation Army church and play an appropriate solo selection in a Sunday morning worship service (date and time to be determined).
 - c. Any winning contestant consents to the unrestricted use of his/her name and photograph in relation to the “Star-Search 2008” competition.
10. Awards and prizes will be presented to winning contestants on the agreed-upon Sunday date.
11. The competition organizers reserve the right to make any changes or exceptions to the contest rules.
